

With our work, we aim to highlight that reusing, besides being one of the pillars for reducing waste, fosters creativity in everyday life and promotes a more self-sufficient way of living.

In our installations, active public participation is essential. This way, we reclaim our squares, parks, and streets as shared spaces for leisure and coexistence.



Our installations thrive on continuous maintenance to improve the mechanisms, and sometimes introduce new games, bringing fresh elements each season.



SOME OF THE OBJECTS WE THROW AWAY HAVE REBELLED. THEY REFUSE TO BE ABANDONED AND FORGOTTEN WHEN THEY GROW OLD.

From the scrap heap emerge shapes, colors, and unusual pieces, and we discover: a circuit on a refrigerator door, a frog-cork jumping off a piece of ski, blinds with colorful traps, a satellite dish guiding a ball, etc.

Els Recicloperats, interactive mechanical games.

This is an itinerant installation of 20 autonomous medium-sized games. Each one is the result of working with used objects or materials to turn them into original games.

The games challenge participants to solve small objectives using basic psychomotor skills along with some ingenuity and strategy.





In this collection, it is particularly surprising that the repurposed objects are easily recognizable, allowing us to create and share new imaginaries for everyday items with the audience.

Recicloperats is probably the first step into Katakraks' world.

Creation

During the creation process of “l’Animalada,” we came up with many interesting game dynamics, but it was hard to fit them into an animal aesthetic. This is how Recicloperats was born—games we have refined and expanded into a completely independent and meaningful installation.

In this project, where aesthetics are freer, we aim to make use of the aesthetic and mechanical possibilities offered by the objects and materials while keeping the found pieces as intact as possible. We delve into their basic essence to extract a hidden playful use. Once discovered, we construct it through simple, functional, safe, and appealing assembly.
